I hope you have had a peaceful Christmas and New Year. Maybe you bought or received a tub of sweets this year, have you run out of ways to use them?

This year Greene King will take any clean tubs with the 5/PP plastic logo between 1st and 31st January. After 31 January, all the tubs are collected and taken to a plastic reprocessing centre where they're shredded, before being sold onto plastic manufacturers to use in place of virgin plastics. All money raised from the sale of Tub 2 Pub plastics will be given directly to Macmillan Cancer Support.
