Starting at The Door Shop at 11.15am

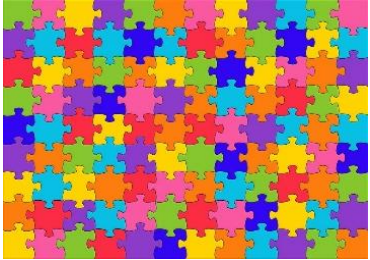
