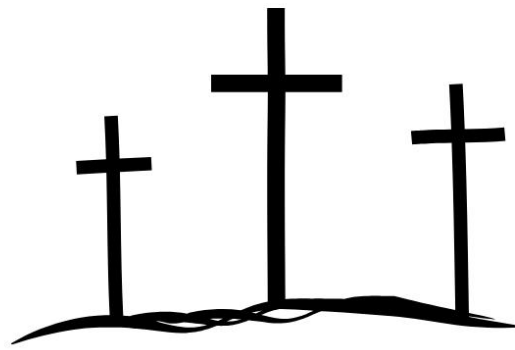
PLANT SALE
